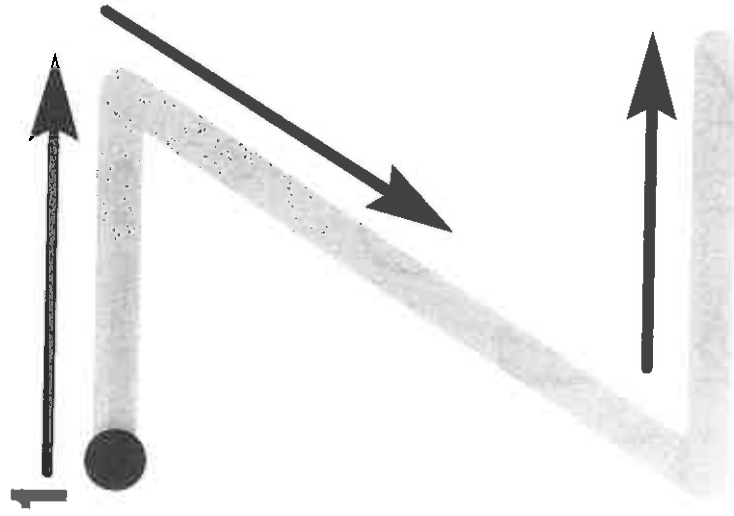


Pick Two New

Z is for zipper.

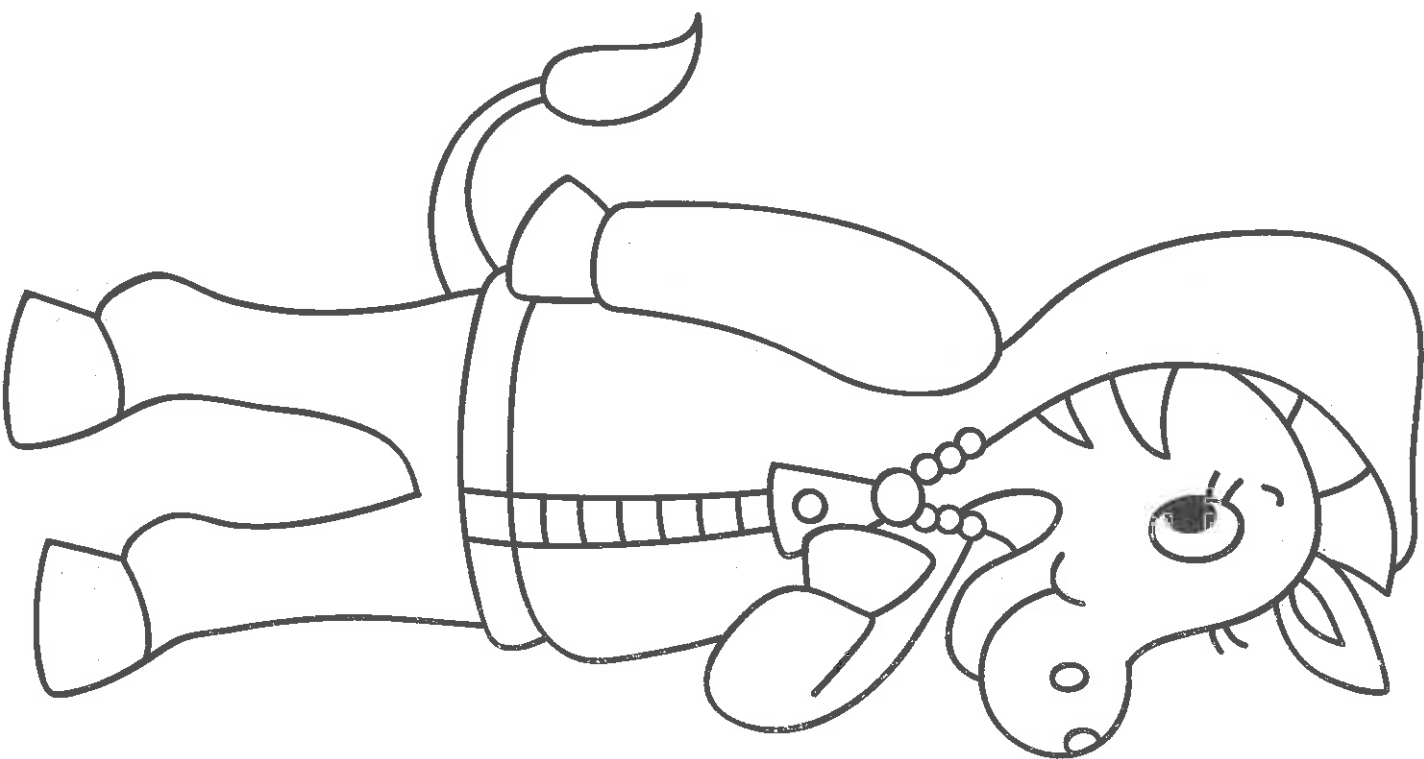

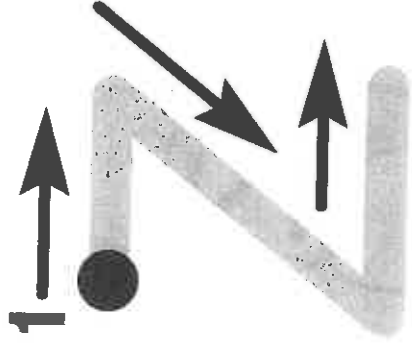


Directions: Ask children to trace and write uppercase **Z** in the boxes above. Encourage them to color the zebra and the zipper as they name each one aloud.

Z is for zoo.



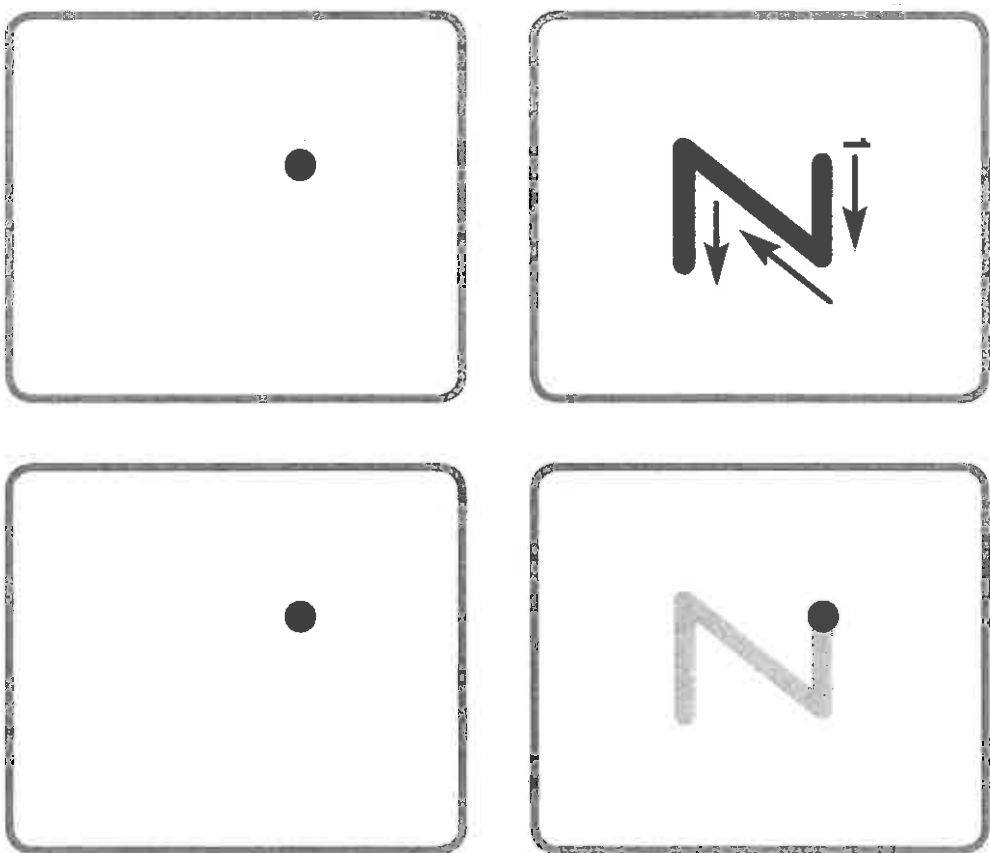
Directions: Invite your child to use a black crayon to write the slide lines in z. Ask him or her to use a white crayon to write the slant line.
